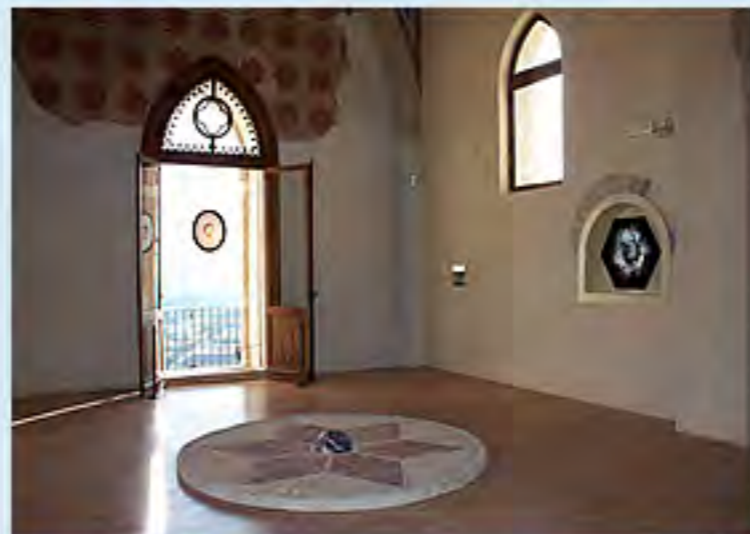

Events is pleased to present a special program in conjunction with the exhibition of the work of acclaimed international artist Denise Milan. A discussion in the gallery will feature the artist in conversation with Greg Cameron, Chief Operating Officer for WTTW-WFMT, formerly Deputy Director, Museum of Contemporary Art, Chicago, and Ronne Hartfield, museum consultant, formerly Executive Director, Museum Education at the Art Institute of Chicago. In September Cameron, Hartfield and the artist were guests at a Fetzer Institute Global Gathering in Assisi, Italy, where a permanent display of Milan's work is now being installed.

Milan's photo collages and stone sculptures are impelled by her commitment to making visible the relationship between stone, as a basic element in the universe, and its inherent messages for human survival on an evolving planet. Participants will share perspectives in an informal setting followed by audience responses. The evening's intimate conversation will include a visual introduction and will be followed by a reception.

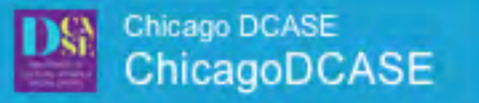

Denise Milan: Mist of the Earth

One of Brazil's visionary artists, **Denise Milan** invites viewers on an exhilarating journey to her country through an exhibition of sculpture and photo-collage that celebrates the natural wonder of Brazil's jungles, ocean and desert regions, and the vibrancy of its multifaceted culture.

Working from a deeply humanistic tradition for more than 20 years—as an ecological and arts education activist, as well as an artist—Denise Milan has been making sculptures, photographic installations and performances that draw actively from her experiences living with and interviewing people in the Brazilian coastal villages of Paraty and the dry desolate lands of Bahia in Brazil's northeast.

Denise Milan: Mist of the Earth is the culmination of past experience and the embodiment of the artist's ongoing concerns, as much a testament to a troubling legacy of colonization, the enslavement of African peoples, and the despoilment of whole regions, as to the more life-asserting side of Brazil, its breathless beauty, sensuous earthiness, and ravishing mysticism.

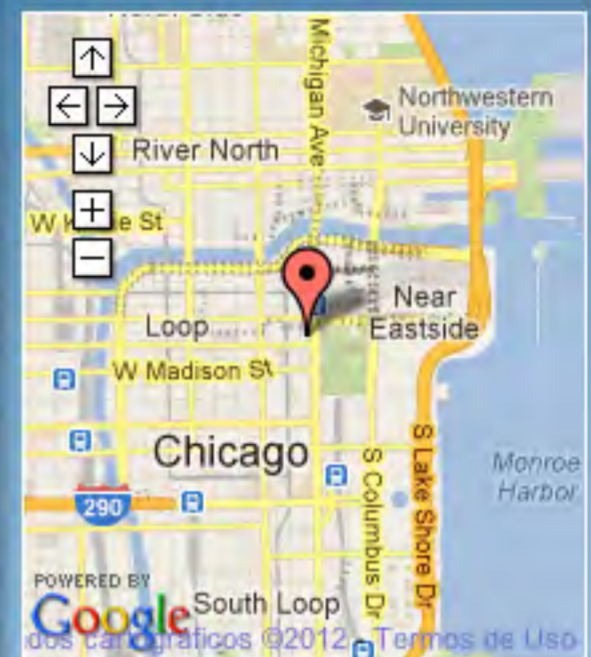
